

Physics Department Policies for Labs

- Lab documents, demonstration videos and PowerPoint slides, and worksheets will be available online through Brightspace.

Lab attendance:

- Lab attendance and participation is **mandatory**.
- Lecture sections registered as “in person” or “face to face” will occur in the scheduled lab room in Langara’s T-building. Individual lab instructors may set up an online feed for their labs.
- If a student is **absent for two or more labs**, for any reason, that student will receive a grade of N (incomplete) for the course, which counts as 0 on their GPA.
- For all labs, if a student **does not submit** a lab report by the deadline **for three or more labs**, that student will receive a grade of N (incomplete) for the course.
- If a student is **late for more than 30 minutes**, for any reason, that student will not be allowed to attend the lab and it will be counted as an absent.
- Provision for health measures will be accommodated on a case-by-case basis.
- If a student has a valid reason for missing a face-to-face lab, that student must notify their Lab Instructor as soon as possible, to allow for an online version or other make-up provision.

Collaboration and Academic Integrity:

- While collaboration is encouraged, identical work will be regarded as copying.
- Copying and plagiarism will not be tolerated.
